III. Informational Report from the NSICF Football Committee.

A. Orland Culp from Yreka High School presented the report

1. The state is planning to add another round to the state playoff system; this will be effective, 2010.
2. The committee drafted a proposal that will start football in the NSCIF a week later, which will match up our season with other sections.
3. A brief discussion was held and further discussion will take place at the NSCIF Board of Managers meeting.
4. Schools should contact their league representative for more information and a copy of the proposal.

IV. Conference broke into league groups for discussion and scheduling.

V. Group Reports

A. Eastern Athletic League

1. Completed their League football schedule. This included drawing for bye date and team. Many schools have a **tentative** schedule for non-league.

2. Agreed that in Basketball, Volleyball, Softball, Baseball and Tennis, a double round robin within each division and 1 game cross over with each team in the other division would be scheduled and all games would count toward the league division championship.

Vote 8-2 with no votes from Oroville and Paradise

3. Cross Country, Track and Wrestling would have a dual against all division teams with no cross over.

4. Other sports would keep the schedules similar to what they have now.

B. Northern Athletic League and Butte View League

1. Reported that they had agreed on scheduling for their leagues. No specifics were discussed.
