Realignment meeting,

November 9, 2010

Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Mike Worley at 9:05 am. Paradise and Yreka were absent at that time, but came in a few minutes later, so all 20 schools were represented. The floor was open for announcements, and there were none. I opened discussion on the 6 proposals that were up for consideration. Scott Fairley, from West Valley suggested that we go through the list and discuss whether each one should be there or not. Proposal #1 was OK for consideration. Proposal 2 was a possibility. Proposal three was scratched. Proposal four and five were scratched. Proposal 6 was OK for discussion. After discussion a call for a vote was made for all sports. The proposal failed, 7 for and 13 opposed. Then Brian McIntire showed his proposal for #6 as a Football Only league. Everyone seemed to like it, so a call to vote was made. It passed 20-0. Someone asked if we could vote on #6 again for all sports and I suggested we move on because we had just voted that down. After we passed 6 for football only, proposal seven was discussed and a vote was taken. It passed 15 to 4 with Lassen stating he could live with it, which made it 16-4 basically. A hand vote was taken, just like we did for the last realignment, where no complaints were filed about order of operations. Winters asked after the vote if there was anyone that couldn't possibly live with it, but no one spoke up, and people stated, we passed it already, there shouldn't be any more discussion.
