The other 3 teams from the Big North (ranks 5-7) will have to play week 0 games vs 3 teams from the Mid Valley. So, Big North #5 plays Mid Valley #1, Big North #6 plays Mid Valley #2, etc. Two of the teams have the option if they wanted to play week 0 or 4 and week 0 or 5, depending on the "rankings". (Cross over games do not count for league)

Possible addition Stipulation #2

The same scenario as above could be set up with Mid Valley teams 4, 5, and 6 vs Big South teams 5, 6, and 7.

Also, if 2 teams from Mid Valley week 6 wanted to play their game early so one team could fill Orland bye and the other fill Chico bye, that would be possible. Both of these ideas were expressed at the meeting. Similarly, if Mid Valley plays the week 0 games with the Big North, that opens up possible opponents for the other Mid Valley schools to schedule in week 4 and 5. All of this could also be done automatically if that is the desire of the schools.

So, here is the beauty of the file attached... the teams in each league are currently "ranked" randomly to demonstrate the formula. If you feel the rankings are not correct, just change the school names in column A by typing in the new teams. Number one team is on top and work your way down. Type the school names in and do not cut and paste as that will mess up the program. When you do that, it will change everywhere in the schedule and you can see what a season would look like.

Below are some of the other ideas that were discussed. The green game could be any 2 Mid Valley teams that wanted to split. The yellow games are also just a random possible scheduling. The bright red is a game that could be scheduled, but if both teams wanted to travel the other direction that would work for both.
