

Football Guidelines

There are a few contradictions in the football guidelines that were approved in May.

On page 2

A. Qualification

1. Divisions I-VI will include the top 6 teams in each division. In Division V and VI, if there are more than ten teams, the committee may switch it to eight playoff teams.
2. ~~Division VI will consist of the top 4 teams in that division.~~
 - a. ~~If the number of schools in division VI drops below 6 schools, only two schools will be included in the playoffs. (See VIII.J).~~
 - b. ~~Schools qualifying for Division VI will determine if and/or how many games will be played.~~

And on page 7

~~If there are six or more teams in the Division VI "league," the top four teams will advance to the Section Finals. The 1st place finisher will play the 4th place finisher, and the 2nd place finisher will play the 3rd place finisher with the winners advancing to the Division VI Section Championship.~~

And add

Division VI will include the top 6 teams in the division, if there are more than ten teams, the committee may switch it to eight playoff teams.
