**AGREEMENT FOR EMPLOYMENT
COMMISSIONER**

THIS AGREEMENT, made as of the signature date shown below, provides for employment of:
ELIZABETH KYLE, 927 Irma Lane, McArthur, CA 96056 as NORTHERN SECTION CIF COMMISSIONER
by the Northern Section CIF (NSCIF) Board of Managers.

The following conditions of employment have been stipulated by the NSCIF Board of Managers and are hereby expressly made a part of this contract:

1. **TERM:** The term of service in the above named position will begin August 1, 2006 and end June 30, 2009 (225 days total, 12 days of sick leave per year). Employee is hereby classified by the NSCIF as a Permanent and Full-time employee, subject to acceptance of this offer.
2. **SALARY:** The annual salary for the school year in the above named position will be \$70,000.00 payable in 12 payments equaling \$5,833.33 per month for 2006-07. The NSCIF Board of Managers does hereby reserve and retain the right to increase the salary provided by this contract at any time during the school year and the period of employment contemplated by this contract. The salary for each of the subsequent years of this contract shall be based upon the yearly evaluation by Board of Managers of Employee's execution of his/her responsibilities. It is agreed that the salary for each of the subsequent years of this contract shall not be less than the salary of the preceding year.
3. **DUTIES:** This contract is subject to all applicable laws and regulations of the State of California and the Board of Managers of the NSCIF. NSCIF and employee understand and agree that Employee will have a flexible schedule, as determined by Employee, provided, that Employee ensures that Duties are adequately carried out.
4. **HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFITS:**
 - a. \$498.59 monthly stipend for Health Insurance Benefits. Amount correlated with Pierce Joint Unified School District Administrative employee health benefit costs.
 - b. \$4,000 annual stipend for Office Rental paid monthly.
 - c. All necessary equipment to perform the duties of above position.
 - d. Provide a cellular phone for Employee uses.
 - e. Mileage reimbursement in accordance with existing NSCIF policy for miles driven while on official duty.
 - f. Lodging, meals, etc., reimbursement in accordance with existing NSCIF policy while on official duty.
5. **EXTENSION OF EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT:** If Employee receives a positive annual evaluation; the Board of Managers will extend Employee's Employment Agreement for one additional year beyond the third year of employment.
6. **TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT:** This Employment Agreement may be terminated by:
 - a. Mutual agreement of the parties.
 - b. NSCIF for "just cause." "Just Cause" shall mean failure or inability of Employee to perform his/her duties in a competent and reasonable manner as determined by the NSCIF Board of Managers. Termination shall be preceded by written notice of performance deficiencies and a hearing before the full Board of Managers prior to termination.

7. IDEMNIFICATION FOR EMPLOYEES: The California Interscholastic Federation Northern Section agrees to defend indemnify, and hold harmless its Commissioner against any and all actions, suits, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, charges, attorney's fees, and all other expenses relating to any and all claims, in law or in equity, of every kind and nature whatsoever, directly or indirectly resulting from its Commissioner's performance of his or her duties and/or responsibilities. The Commissioner's right to defense, indemnification and holding harmless shall not exist for willful misconduct, intentional acts, and gross negligence by the Commissioner during the course and scope of his or her duties and/or responsibilities.

8. OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT: This offer of employment is made subject to the laws of California and to the lawful rules of the governing board of the above named body. Said laws and rules are hereby made a part of the term and conditions of this offer of employment, the same as though they had been expressly set forth herein.
