## Realignment

### 512.1 NSCIF REALIGNMENT

#### A. Conference and League Formation

1. The purpose of the Conference is the formation of leagues among member schools within the Conference.
2. There shall be three Conferences within the Northern Section with all schools within the section assigned to a conference. Each conference's member schools will be generally proximate. Original placement within a conference will be proposed by the 1999-2000 Realignment Committee and ratified by the Board of Managers. All future changes to a school's conference alignment must occur through a petition at the beginning of a new realignment cycle.
3. Each Conference will select a Conference Chairperson to preside over the realignment process within the Conference. The member schools within each Conference will select the Chairperson. The Chairperson will facilitate the process for the formation of leagues within the Conference. Their term of office will be for two years. Additionally, each Chairperson may be asked to serve on the NSCIF Appeals Panel as needed.
4. Each Conference will establish a process by which decisions will be made by member schools regarding league formations.
5. Quorum. A quorum shall consist of two-thirds of conference member schools. A quorum shall be required in order to conduct any conference business. In the event that a quorum is not attained at any conference meeting, which has been scheduled, the Conference Chairperson may call a subsequent meeting ten (10) or more calendar days hence. A quorum at such a re-scheduled meeting shall consist of those present at the re-scheduled meeting provided 51 % of conference members are in attendance.
6. The Conference Chairs, Realignment Chair, and the Section Commissioner will meet in the odd numbered years to consider the placement and/or movement of schools in conferences. This committee will make a recommendation to the Executive Committee at their winter meeting for the next realignments cycles. The Executive Committee will make a recommendation at the winter Board of Managers Meeting.

#### B. REALIGNMENT APPEAL PROCEDURE

1. The NSCIF Appeals Panel will consist of the Realignment and Conference Chairpersons.
2. Any school may appeal its conference placement to the Realignment Chairperson in writing ten days prior to the first conference meeting or within ten days from the recommendation for league formation from the Conference Chairperson. When in receipt of a written appeal, the Appeals Panel will convene an opening meeting of the affected schools to listen to proposed solutions. The Appeals Panel will render a decision. The decision shall be final unless appealed to the Board of Managers.
3. The Board of Managers shall either approve the Conference formation(s) OR refer the unresolved issues back to the conference(s) for resolution.
4. The Board of Managers shall consider the new recommendations for conference formation. The Board of Managers shall render a final decision on placement of schools within conferences and leagues at the March meeting.
5. An appeal of the final decision of the Section Board of Managers may be filed with the State CIF according to CIF Bylaws, Article 1100. (See State CIF Constitution)

## 512.2 REALIGNMENT TIMELINE

- A. 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of September even-numbered years. The Conference Chairperson will convene a meeting of representatives from member schools to meet and discuss placement of schools. Each school shall send a member empowered by their respective school board to speak for the school. Those schools wishing to change conference alignment, league or Section membership must submit their proposal to the Realignment and Conference Chairpersons in writing at least ten days prior to the first conference meeting.
- B. 4<sup>th</sup> Week of October even-numbered years. Each Conference Chairperson shall inform the Realignment Chairperson of tentative placement of schools in each Conference.
- C. 2<sup>nd</sup> Week of November even-numbered years. The NSCIF Appeals Panel shall hold open meetings on individual school's appeal of a tentative placement of schools in a conference.
- D. Winter Board of Managers even-numbered years. The Board of Managers shall adopt the placement of schools in each conference unless there is an appeal.

Issues that came up that we may want to consider-

1. Schools forfeit their right to appeal the decision if they did not attend the meeting.
2. Section set the order of priority- enrollment, geography competitive equity- or have the conference set it prior to beginning the process.
3. Stating somewhere at any realignment meeting decisions can be made that are forwarded to the Board of Managers.
4. People in attendance have the ability to make decisions for the school. Does this mean the meeting should not stop for phone calls back to the school?
5. The appeal panel- The conference chair from the appealing conference, should he be part of the appeal panel voting on the issue?

### **D. PHYSICAL CONDITIONING PRACTICE (CIF BYLAW 1903)**

A high school shall not conduct a physical conditioning practice session during the summer prior to the opening date of authorized football practice, unless so authorized by the appropriate CIF Section.

### **H. OUT OF SEASON ACTIVITIES (NSCIF BYLAW 1904.2)**

Football will be treated the same as other sports with the exception of the use of football equipment. The football will be the only equipment allowed. Sleds, bags, and any other equipment will not be allowed outside the season of sport. Exception: 1904.2.B

Contract Information Regarding Officials Fees

Fall Sports-

Invoices are due and payable upon receipt. Schools may make arrangements with associations to make payments in increments of three installments due September 14, September 30, and October 15 each year.

Winter Sports-

Invoices are due and payable upon receipt. Schools may make arrangements with associations to make payments in increments of three installments due December 16, January 6, and January 20 each year.

Spring Sports-

Invoices are due and payable upon receipt. Schools may make arrangements with associations to make payments in increments of three installments due March 9, March 23, and March 30 each year.

Associations might not assign officials to school's contests if the 3<sup>rd</sup> installment date is not met by that school.

Member schools will submit schedules to their respective Associations one month prior to the NSCIF published "first allowable contest" for that sport.

Additional Compensation for Long-Distance Travel for regular season and playoff games. An additional compensation of \$14 will be paid to each official, excluding the driver, that is required to travel to the host school in excess of 90 miles round trip. (excluding football)

**Football only**-Travel fee-Additional compensation for Long-Distance Travel for regular season and playoff games - an additional \$60 for a 5-man crew or \$48 for a 4-man crew(or fraction there of) compensation will be paid to the association when travel to the host school is in excess of 90 miles round trip.

**Cancellation of Games**

If assigned officials report to the site of a canceled or postponed game because they were not notified three (3) hours prior to the game they will be compensated one-half (1/2) the single game fee plus mileage. Four (4) hours notification is needed for schools in excess of 90 miles from assigned officials.

If the event of the non-arrival of officials, the contest may proceed by mutual consent of the competing schools and if in compliance with the NFHS rules of the sport. If mutually agreed upon the game will count as a win/loss in computing standings and for playoff purposes. Schools may not pay more or less than the above designated amount.
