

Adamson/LeMaster/Hendrix Scholar-Athlete Application Form

NORTHERN SECTION LEAGUE PRESIDENTS:

We are pleased to announce the competition for the LeMaster/Hendrix Northern Section Scholar/Athlete of the Year. This award is presented annually to honor two students, one female and one male, from an NSCIF member school. These candidates must have demonstrated outstanding ability athletically, above average scholastic achievement, and high standards of citizenship during their high school years.

QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify, the applicant must be a graduating senior, possess no less than a 3.5 (weighted or non-weighted) cumulative GPA, have participated in a varsity sport in the Northern Section for at least two years, have earned at least one all league selection, and have a record of good citizenship. **Note:** Only 1 (one) All-League per sport per year. Only 1 (one) NSCIF Championship per sport per year (**not per event**).

METHOD OF APPLICATION

The Deadline for the League filing applications is **May 1**. The entire application must be received by that date; late or incomplete applications will not be considered. **Note:** Schools may submit one application for one male and one female only. Each application must be accompanied by:

1. All pages of the application (A & B).
2. An essay on "Pursuing Victory With Honor." The essay does not have to be handwritten.
3. Coaches Recommendation-one page only.
4. Athletic Director's Recommendation-one page only.

SCHOOL NOMINEES

- a. **One Female and One Male** from each school may be submitted to the League by the school.
- b. Each school must send the completed application(s) to their **league selection committee** by: _____ *(date determined by league)

LEAGUE NOMINEES

- a. **One Female and One Male** from each league is submitted to the NSCIF Scholarship Committee by the League.
- b. The NSCIF Scholarship committee will accept only applications that are **complete** and **submitted by the league**. **Applications submitted by individual schools without League approval will not be accepted.**
- c. The NSCIF Scholarship committee will accept completed applications **from the league** no later than **May 1**.
