The SCL sent the following email out –

The Shasta Cascade League is working on a proposal to create a post-season inter-league soccer tournament in the fall. We would like to invite the Pioneer and Evergreen Leagues to participate in this tournament and ask that you please present the concept of a post-season tournament at your upcoming league meetings for consideration. If agreed upon by the three leagues and approved at the Section level, the tournament may be implemented in the 2011-12 school year. It would not be a Section Championship, but rather an opportunity for smaller schools competing in the fall to have a form of playoffs.

At this time we are asking your leagues to consider the concept, we obviously need to create a seeding formula and formal playoff guidelines if there is interest.
