The Mt. Shasta Resort Golf Club and the NSCIF welcome you to the 2006 Section Girls Golf Championships. We are guests of Mt. Shasta Resort Golf Club. Please replace all divots, repair all ball marks and rake all sand traps. It is important that all players conduct themselves in the manner of good sportsmanship on the course as well as in and around the clubhouse.

Mt. Shasta Resort Golf Club is located in Mt. Shasta, 1000 Siskiyou Lake Blvd., Highway 5 to central Mt. Shasta exit. Practice rounds, after 12 noon on Monday, 10/30 are being provided by the course management at no cost to the qualifiers. They can be arranged by calling Mr. JJ Abraham, in the Pro Shop, at 530-926-3052. The course offers a snack bar, golf shop and driving range. Range balls will be provided on the day of the championship..

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The Rules of golf as approved by the United States Golf Association will be enforced. The NSCIF golf committee and coaches will marshal the golf course. Any questions on rules or interpretation of rules should be directed to the committee members. Hopefully a scorer will be provided to escort each foursome, but each individual will be responsible to keep a scorecard. The Committee along with the club professional will make the final decision on all rule interpretations.

Dress code: No denim jeans/shorts or riveted jeans/shorts are allowed. Team walking shorts are allowed, but must be hemmed and an appropriate length. Collared team golf shirts will be worn and kept tucked in at all times. Hats must be worn with the bill forward. Soft spikes only! Failure to comply with the dress code may result in disqualification.

Tee times: Times will begin at 10:00 am. Golfers will be paired by their qualifying scores. Tee times and pairings will be posted around the pro shop.

Play: Play will be from the Gold Tees (5101 yards/slope 118) and will be with summer rules.

Player Check-in: A qualifying team roster must have been received by the tournament director by 3:00 PM, Friday, October 27th. Team/individuals are to check-in with the tournament director (Len Massaro) by 9:15 am., the day of the event.

Scoring: A coach will be paired with each group and will keep an unofficial group card. The players will each keep someone else's card. Cards must be signed and attested before being turned in to the scorer's table at the end of the tournament.

Qualifiers: The top two teams and the top four individuals not on those two teams qualify for the NORCAL HS Championships at Yolo Fliers Golf Club in Woodland on Monday, November 6, 2006.

Coaches: Prior to play, review rules for playing hazards, provisional balls and scoring. Please remember that no coaching is allowed during the course of play!

Galleries: We encourage spectators to attend this championship event. However, all spectators must stay 30 yards or more from the players. Spectators are to follow the golfers on the cart paths and not down the fairway.

Competitor's Sheet

Tournament Guidelines:

1. 18 holes of medal play - USGA rules will apply. Putt everything out! Pace of play: **4.5** hours!
2. Summer rules: Play the ball as it lies!
3. The tournament will be played from the Gold Tees.
4. Exchange scorecards with someone in your foursome that does not have your scorecard Use two vertical boxes to record the score on each hole. Make numbers neat and precise. Keep your score on the bottom. Check hole by hole scores carefully before signing and turning in the card. If you sign for a lower score on any hole you will be disqualified. If you sign for a higher score on any hole that is what you will get. Do not worry about adding your scores, the tournament officials will take care of the addition. Get two signatures on each card at the end of 18 holes.
5. Remember, it is a two stroke penalty for swearing or club throwing, so use good golf etiquette – don't get yourself disqualified.
It is also a two stroke penalty for giving or asking for advice – don't do it!
6. Slow play – Each group should try to keep up with the group in front of them. If needed, a group will be warned once to speed up pace of play. Each subsequent offense will result in a one-stroke penalty on each member of the group.
7. Be able to identify your ball (a special mark that makes it different from any other ball that is the same brand and number).
8. Hit a provisional ball if your ball might be out of bounds or lost. Make sure that you state in advance that you are hitting a provisional ball.
9. All hazards are clearly marked.
10. If you have any questions with respect to a ruling that can't be determined on the course, play two balls and write down both scores. We will get a ruling at the end of the round.
11. Pull carts are allowed. Keep your golf bags and pull-carts off all tee boxes and the aprons around the greens.
12. Leave the course in better condition than when you started: replace all divots, repair all ball marks, rake all sand traps, etc., Have fun and enjoy your day of golf!!!!
