Re: Mandatory 2006 Rules Interpretation Meetings

You are requested to attend one of the rules interpretation meetings listed below. As the individuals and associations who are responsible for the training of high school basketball officials, you know the importance of statewide consistency in the interpretation and application of the rules. These meetings are crucial to that endeavor, as well as to your work in instructing the officials who are members of your local associations.

Attendance at one of these meetings is mandatory for your association. The State CIF, supported by the ten sections, requires that the instructional chair, or designee, of each association attend this informational meeting. Fulfillment of this requirement is one condition of maintaining your association's accreditation. Associations that fail to attend one of the meetings, their membership will not be eligible for post-season playoff assignments at the section and state level. If your association is a "multi-sport" organization, please be sure that your basketball instructional chair, or designee, attends.

John Lozano, the State CIF Basketball Rules Interpreter will lead these meetings and present information received at the National Federation Rules Interpreters Clinic held in Indianapolis in early October, including discussion of new rules and points of emphasis for the 2006-2007 basketball season.

The Northern California meeting will be a CIF Rule Interpreters meeting only; however, members of the CBOA Board of Directors will be available to answer any questions that northern California units may have regarding the CBOA/NASO partnership. The Southern California meeting will operate as it has for the past dozen years with the State CIF Rules Interpreter working in conjunction with CBOA.
