Things to consider...

I have heard that some schools have enrolled students without grades from the previous semester.

I would like to paraphrase Bylaw 205 governing scholastic eligibility.

The minimum requirement for continuing scholastic eligibility is four fold:

1. The student is currently enrolled in 20 semester units.
2. The student was passing in the equivalent of at least 20 semester credits at the completion of the last grading period.
3. The student is maintaining minimum progress towards meeting the high school graduation requirements.
4. The student has a minimum 2.0 GPA during the previous grading period.

A student who enters a high school without verification of grades is not eligible for interscholastic competition until he/she has received grades. If you have any questions please give the Section Office a call.

A reminder that the Junior Varsity classification is for student/athletes that are in their first four semesters of attendance.

Face painting and artificial noise makers are prohibited.

The softball committee strongly recommends that water be available for all athletes.
