Tuscan Ridge Golf Club and the NSCIF welcome you to the 2008 Boys Golf Division I Championships. We are guests of Tuscan Ridge Golf Club. Please replace all divots, repair all ballmarks and rake all sand traps. It is important that all players conduct themselves in the manner of good sportsmanship on the course as well as in and around the clubhouse.

Tuscan Ridge Golf Club is located at 3100 Skyway on the way to Paradise about 4 miles east of Chico. On highway 99 take the Skyway exit east towards Paradise. The course is about 5 miles from the highway exit. Practice rounds can be arranged by calling Mr. Jay Berkowitz, PGA Club Pro, at 530-624-7006. Junior rates for rounds are \$10. Qualifying team/individuals must be accompanied to the section tournaments by a certified coach as defined in CIF bylaw 506 or have a letter signed by the school's principal stating that he/she represents the school.

An entry fee check should be mailed to the Northern Section CIF Commissioner's Office (c/o Liz Kyle, P.O. Box 9330, Red Bluff, CA 96080) prior to competition.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

The Rules of golf as approved by the United States Golf Association will be enforced. The NSCIF golf committee and coaches will marshal the golf course. Any questions on rules or interpretation of rules should be directed to the committee members. Hopefully a scorer will be provided to escort each foursome, but each individual will be responsible to keep a scorecard.

The Committee along with the club professional will make the final decision on all rule interpretations.

Dress code: No denim jeans/shorts or riveted jeans/shorts are allowed. Team walking shorts are allowed, but must be hemmed. Collared team golf shirts will be worn and kept tucked in at all times. Hats must be worn with the bill forward. Soft spikes only! Failure to comply with the dress code may result in disqualification.

Tee times: Times will begin at 10:30 am. Golfers will be paired by their qualifying scores.

Pairings will be posted around the pro shop.

Course services: Range balls will be provided. Pro shop will be open. Snack cart on course may be available.

Play: Play will be from the White Tees and will be with summer rules.

**Coaches/Players: Your qualifying team roster must have been received by the tournament director by 3:00 PM, Friday, May 2th. Make sure that your team/individuals have checked in with the tournament director (Jack Danielson) by 9:45 am. on the date of the tournament.**

Scoring: A coach will be paired with each group as marshal. The marshal will keep a group card. The players will each keep someone else's card. Cards must be signed and attested before being turned in to the scorer's table at the end of the tournament.

Qualifiers: The top three teams, the top four individuals not on those three teams, and any player who shoots 79 or better will qualify for the NSCIF Section Championship at Graeagle Meadows on Tuesday, May 13, 2008 at 11 am. Practice rounds are available after 2 pm on Monday May 12, 2008 for \$30.

Coaches: Please remember that no coaching is allowed during the course of play! Please remind parents they may not speak to competitors during play. It is distracting to other players in the grouping.

Galleries: We encourage spectators to attend this championship event. However, all spectators must stay 15 yards or more from the players. Spectators are to follow the golfers on the cart paths and not down the fairway. A breach of this rule may result in a two stroke penalty assessed to the player and possible disqualification.

Electronic Devices: For safety reasons, all electronic devices (cell phones, media players, etc.) are banned from all NSCIF competitions.

**Competitor's Sheet**

Tournament Guidelines:

1. 18 holes of medal play - USGA rules will apply. Putt everything out! Pace of play: 4.5 hours!
2. Summer rules: Play the ball as it lies!
3. The tournament will be played from the White Tees.
4. Exchange scorecards with someone in your foursome that does not have your scorecard Use two vertical boxes to record the score on each hole. Make numbers neat and precise. Keep your score on the bottom. Check hole by hole scores carefully before signing and turning in the card. If you sign for a lower score on any hole you will be disqualified. If you sign for a higher score on any hole that is what you will get. Do not worry about adding your scores, the tournament officials will take care of the addition. **It is each players responsibility to watch and keep an opponents score. You are protecting the field by being a marker.**

Get two signatures on each card at the end of 18 holes.

5. Remember, it is a two stroke penalty for swearing or club throwing, so use good golf etiquette – don't get yourself disqualified.

It is also a two stroke penalty for giving or asking for advice – don't do it!

6. Slow play – Each group should try to keep up with the group in front of them. If needed, a group will be warned once to speed up pace of play. Each subsequent offense will result in a one-stroke penalty on each member of the group.

7. Hit a provisional ball if your ball might be out of bounds or lost. Make sure that you state in advance that you are hitting a provisional ball. Help other members in your group find balls that maybe lost. Help watch all shots so you may assist when needed to find a ball.

**8. A pre-tee meeting will be held at 10:15AM to answer any rules or procedural questions. Player is responsible for knowing local rules.**

9. If you have any questions with respect to a ruling that can't be determined on the course, play two balls and write down both scores. We will get a ruling at the end of the round from the rules committee.
10. Keep your golf bags off all tee boxes and the aprons around the greens.
11. Be able to identify your ball (a special mark that makes it different from any other ball that is the same brand and number).
12. Leave the course in better condition than when you started: replace all divots, repair all ball marks, rake all sand traps, etc., Have fun and enjoy your day of golf!!!!
