Arrowhead Golf Course and the NSCIF welcome you to the boys 2008 Division II Golf Championship. We are guests of Arrowhead Golf Course and remind all participants to please replace all divots, repair all ball marks, and rake all sand traps. It is important that all players conduct themselves in the manner of good sportsmanship on the course as well as in and around the clubhouse. An entry fee of \$30.00 per team and \$5.00 per individual must be collected prior to the tournament. Make checks payable to *NSCIF Golf*.

Coaches: Check in with the Tournament Director, Harold Montague, by 10:00 am to pay entry fee and receive marker/hole assignments.

Arrowhead Golf Course is a nine hole, public golf course located in Alturas, CA. Alturas, CA is located at the intersection of Hwy 299 and Hwy 395. From Redding travel east on Hwy 299 east to Alturas. As you enter the city limits turn left on to Warner Street (just past Holiday Market) and continue to the end of the street to the golf course. From Susanville take Hwy 395 north to Hwy 299. Turn left on Hwy 299 (west) and right on Warner Street (just before Holiday Market) and continue to the end of the street to the golf course.

Rules and Regulations

The Rules of golf as approved by the United States Golf Association will be enforced. The tournament will be marshaled by the NSCIF golf committee and by school coaches and representatives. Any questions on rules or interpretation of rules should be directed to the committee members. A scorer will be provided to escort each foursome, but each individual will also keep a scorecard (see below). The Committee, along with the club's professional, will make the final decision on all rule interpretations.

Dress Code: No denim jeans/shorts or riveted jeans/shorts are allowed. Team walking shorts are allowed, but must be hemmed. Collared or Mock Tee team golf shirts will be worn and kept tucked in at all times. Hats must be worn with the "bill" forward. Soft spikes only! Failure to comply with the dress code may result in disqualification.

Tee Times: The tournament will start at 11:00 am with a modified shotgun start. Golfers will be paired based on their scoring average for 18 holes during league play. Tee assignments and pairings will be posted around the pro shop. Make sure that your team/individuals have checked in with the tournament director (Harold Montague) by 10:00 am.

Play: Play will be from the Mens Tees (Blue on front, White on back) with a total yardage of 6236 yards.

Players: Participants are as follows: First and second place finishers from the Shasta Cascade, Butte View, and the Greater Mountain Valley/Sacramento Valley leagues, and top Independent team (who must have finished as the #1 or #2 team in the Feather River League) AND up to three individuals per non-qualifying teams who averaged 90 (bogey golf) or less in league play. If there are any last minute changes please contact me at home by 5:00 pm on Sunday, May 4, 2008 (233-2186 or at hjmont@hdo.net).

Scoring: A school representative will be paired with each group. This individual is the *marker* for their assigned group and will keep a group scorecard. The players will each keep someone else's scorecard. Cards must be signed and attested before turning in to the scorer's table at the end of the tournament. Once they are signed and turned in they become the official score (no more corrections/changes).

Qualifiers: The top two teams and the top four individuals not of the top team, plus ties, and any individual who shoots 79 or lower qualify for the NSCIF Championships on Tuesday, May 13, 2008 at Graeagle Meadows Golf Club in Graeagle, CA.

Coaches: Please remember that no coaching is allowed during the course of tournament play.

Galleries: We encourage spectators to attend this championship event. However, all spectators must stay 15 yards or more from the players. Spectators are to follow the golfers on the cart paths, where available or along the sides of the fairways and not down the fairway with the golfers.

Other:

- A practice round is available for \$10.00/person on Monday, May 5, 2008. Please call in advance to reserve your tee time (530-233-3404). Range balls will be available for a small fee on both days.
- Lodging is available at several hotels in Alturas, CA. The Best Western Hotel (1-530-233-4111) has offered schools a special rate which includes a continental breakfast for \$60.00/room.
- School representatives may also be asked to monitor holes to help speed up play.
- OB is determined by the course perimeter fence.
- Food will be available throughout the practice and championship rounds at the course.
