Thank you to everyone who attended the Administrative Workshop and contributed to its success.

A couple of issues to remember...

On the 207 forms, please pay attention to #8 on the first page. To be considered complete, I need the previous school's administration to sign which sports the student participated in the previous year.

On the 510 form, make sure the coaches from both schools have signed.

After the 207 and 510 forms are complete, please make a copy and mail the originals to: NSCIF Section Office. P.O. Box 9330, Red Bluff, CA. 96080.

To check the status of your transfer paperwork, please go to the Section web page, then click on *status*, on the left hand page. To get your password, email Cindy and she will send it to you.

Remember that you must allow 20 working days maximum for the paperwork to be approved at the Section Office. Hardship requests take longer time to process than the limited, first transfers, and non participation 207 requests.

If you have a football player who is wearing a cast, the note from the doctor is supposed to state that the cast is to protect an injury. There is a form on-line.

Remember the new soccer shin guard rule becomes affective this year. Make sure all of your players are wearing approved shin guards and that they do not alter them, including not removing the tags.

October 1, 2008, is the deadline for opting down to Division VI for volleyball playoffs.

According to our **Sportsmanship Guidelines**, face painting is allowed but body paint is prohibited at both indoor and outdoor activities. Artificial noise makers are prohibited in the gym but allowed outside. This includes, but is not limited to, megaphones, clappers, and bells.

Please pay particular attention to the Div. I and II swimming dates.

Update the information for your school in the directory and Cindy will send you your coaches and Board Passes If your school has outstanding invoices from the 2007-08 school year, your passes will not be mailed until the Section receives payment.

Please be aware that Section Passes are to be honored at all sanctioned events, including tournaments

Please remember to have your coaches go on-line to www.maxpreps.com to record your wins and losses, since that is the site we use for seeding into the playoffs.
