## Things to remember...

All Section issued passes must be honored for tournament games, even those intended as a fundraising event.

As a Condition of Membership (Bylaw 22) and continued membership a member school agrees to ensure that all coaches, paid and unpaid, by Dec. 31, 2008, will have completed a coaching education program. Failure to comply will result in administrative regulations and sanctions.

A reminder that the Junior Varsity classification is for student/athletes that are in their first four semesters of attendance.

Body painting and artificial noise makers are prohibited in gyms.

## Bylaw 205.3 Grade Changes

Other than incomplete make-ups, grades changed in the Northern Section (except for clerical and typographical error) will not be considered for scholastic eligibility.

## Bylaw 1607. Mercy Rule

When at the conclusion of the third quarter (of basketball), or any point thereafter, if there is a point differential of forty (40) or more points, a running clock shall be instituted for the remainder of the game, regardless of the score. This applies to all levels of play.
