SUBJECT: Northern California Golf Championships Information

**1. Practice Rounds at Corral de Tierra CC**

Corral de Tierra Country Club, Corral de Tierra has graciously donated the use of its fine golf course for the Northern California CIF Golf Championships on Nov. 10, 2008. Its generosity is truly appreciated. Fewer and fewer courses are willing to make this commitment. In order to protect the course's membership from the many teams desiring to play practice rounds, the Tournament Committee has voted to prohibit any practice rounds as of October 1, 2008. Only Corral de Tierra Country Club members or any high schools that use this facility on a regular basis will be allowed to play said course.

There will be no complimentary practice rounds for the Northern California CIF Golf Championships. No player or coach, except for those stated above, will be permitted to play, walk or be on the tournament site from October 1, 2008 until November 10, 2008. PENALTY for breach of this rule will be disqualification. Please HONOR this rule. The continuance of playing the Northern California CIF Championships on a high quality private course is a privilege. Please do not attempt to abuse this privilege.

**2. Tee Times and Coaches Meeting for Northern California Championships**

All play will begin from the 1st and 10th tees, with the first groups starting at 8:00 a.m. There will be a coaches meeting on Sunday, Nov. 9, 2008 at Corral de Tierra CC at 5:00 p.m. to pick up tee times for your player(s) and a session to go over local rules. It will be permissible for players and coaches to walk the course beginning at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, Nov. 9. The putting green and chipping area only will be available for student practice beginning at 4:30 p.m. until the conclusion of the meeting. The meeting for the coaches is not mandatory, but is highly recommended and you will be able to ask any questions about local rules and to get the tee times for your player(s). The tee times will also be available by Friday afternoon (Nov. 7) at the NCGA Web site at [www.ncga.org](http://www.ncga.org) and the CIF State Web site at [www.cifstate.org](http://www.cifstate.org).

**3. Coaching PROHIBITED at the Northern California CIF Golf Championships**

Despite the USGA rule change which allows coaching in team competition, coaching will be prohibited at the Northern California CIF Golf Championships.

**4. Qualifiers to Northern California CIF Golf Championships**

The Sac-Joaquin Section will qualify the following number of teams and players to the Nor-Cal Championships: Three (3) six-person teams and four (4) individuals.

**5. Qualifiers to CIF State Golf Championships.**

The NorCal tournament will qualify the following number of teams and players to the State Tournament: Three (3) six-person teams and six (6) individuals. The tournament will be held at Red Hill Country Club in Rancho Cucamonga on Tuesday, November 18, 2008. Information regarding the State Tournament will be distributed at the NorCal Tournament.

**Note: The format for the NorCal Championships will be six players, count five!!**
