In the last few days, the teams have been up-dating their game results on max preps. Kevin Askeland has been diligently updating the seeding formula from the max preps page. If you take a look at the last up-dated version of the play-points the seedings appear to be falling into place. I appreciate the effort on your part by asking your coaches to get all their information updated.

The committee is going to meet at 9:00 on Sat morning (2-13-10) at Foothill high school and finalize the seedings for the play-offs. It is quite crucial that your league reps are present to represent the schools in your league during this meeting.
