- D. Hunsaker Report: Looked into “Service Club” running snack shack with % of profit going to participating schools...maybe only top seeds receive % of snack shack monies...to be determined.
 - aa. Lions’ of Redding were very interested with % snack shack to club and divided between participating schools.

IV. Alignment with the State Schedule...

V. Dead Period:

- B. “Dead Week” will be 7 days prior to the NSCIF’s official Start Date.
 - aa. No Coach/Player Contact Allowed (to include weight-training, conditioning, team meetings, and/or equipment distribution).
 - bb. Violation Enforcement – Lose 2 consecutive practice days for every day violated during “Dead Week”.
 - cc. Motion (West Valley): “Dead Week” Rule would begin for the 2011 season.

VI. Spring Practice:

- A. Motion (CV/Yreka) - Schools get 10 days of “Spring Practice” in Helmets prior to Graduation.

VII. Summer Camps (Changed from “Out of Season”):

- A. Reproposal - The NSCIF will allow 10 days in football gear outside of the regular season to attend “authorized” team camps. (Individual language will not change).

VIII. Out of Season Activities

- A. Proposal – FB By-laws “H” to read: Football will be treated the same as other sports with the exception of the use of “player protective gear”. The use of: sleds, bags, and any other practice equipment WILL be allowed outside the season of sport.
