

2012 Masters – Important Notices

COACHES PASSES

Two (2) coaches passes and two (2) statistician passes will be issued to each team with qualified NSCIF Masters Competitors. All coaches must **certified** to be on the floor with the wrestlers. Per CIF guidelines, the NFHS “Fundamentals of Coaching” Course, the ASEP “Coaching Principles” and the ASEP “CIF Coaching Orientation” courses meet California’s **certification** standards for Coaching Education. Please provide your list of certified coaches prior to February 24th.

ADDITIONAL COACHES PASSES

Additional coaches passes will be sold for \$15 each during weigh-ins both days, February 24th and 25th. Additional Coaches passes will only be sold to **certified coaches**.

ATHLETE ENTRY

The only fee required for wrestlers competing in the 2012 NSCIF Masters Tournament is \$10 fee, payable to NSCIF. Alternates to a weight class must weigh-in and make their weight class to qualify for free entry.

HEAD COACH

The Head Coach is responsible for the actions of their assistant coaches, wrestlers, statisticians and verification of NFHS certification.

FOOD/DRINK

All athletes are allowed to bring food and drink to the 2012 Masters. All food must be stored and eaten in designated areas **ONLY**. No food or drinks is allowed in the stands/seating areas – a requirement of the Redding Convention Center which, will be actively enforced.

FACILITY CARE

Use of the Redding Convention Center is a privilege that the Northern Section Masters Tournament would like to maintain. The facility, under new management, has allowed us to continue our Masters Tournament based on our history of running a great event. It is all of our responsibility to comply with convention center requirements.
