

Baseball Championship Fields

Based on a Board of Managers decision on Dec. 5, 2007, the following criteria was established in order for schools to host baseball playoff games.

Listed below are the divisions for this year's baseball playoffs. The Board of Managers has approved for the championship game to be played on the highest seeded team's field, provided it meets the Northern Section Standards for hosting a game. The second page is taken from the Playoff Guidelines that outline the recommendations for a baseball field.

Please meet with you baseball coaching staff and determine if any of the schools in your division have baseball fields that are unacceptable. Please notify (via email or fax) the Section Office by April 1st of the fields that are not up to standard in your division. If 70% of the schools in the division think the field is acceptable, then the school will be allowed to host the divisional championship game. If 30% of the schools in your division feel you do not have an acceptable field you will need to host the game at an alternate site.

APPENDIX A FACILITY STANDARDS

It is the intent of the NSCIF, the NSCIF Baseball Advisory Committee, and the NSCIF Board of Managers that the best possible site be used for all NSCIF section Championship Baseball Games. The following criteria should be considered as meeting minimum standards for the NSCIF Championship Baseball Game. Please submit facility standards to the Section Office upon notification of entry into Section Tournament.

1. All dirt infields are most desirable. All grass infields with well-defined infield/outfield and base areas considered suitable. Grass and dirt infield least desirable.
2. Adequate backstop.
3. Outfield fence.
4. Foul poles (foul pole “wings” preferable).
5. Spacious covered dugouts with water most desirable. (Bat racks and helmet racks preferable).
6. Designated bullpen areas.
7. Ballpark completely fenced. (If not, well-defined “out of play” lines).
8. Adequate spectator seating.
9. Flag pole for National Anthem. (Color Guard will be sufficient, temporary or permanent.)
10. Spectator parking close to the field.
11. Restrooms conveniently located near the field. (Portable toilets if necessary).
12. Concessions stand.
13. Public address system.
14. Scoreboard (electric or manual).
